Congratulations! The Pleasant Valley Recreation and Park District is happy to notify you that your application to participate in the 48th Annual Christmas Parade has been approved. We know your entry will be a great addition to the parade theme "A Healthful Holiday" and will be enjoyed by the thousands of spectators lining the parade route.

The check-in time for your entry is noted in the enclosed unit line-up schedule. Your entry representative will need to check-in at the entrance of the staging area with a parade official (intersection of Temple and Aloha). Once you've been checked-in, you will be given your parade number which is the same as your line-up number and assigned a staging location.

This year the Float & Specialty Units will line up together on one side of Temple Avenue. Please use Charter Oak Park as a "meeting area" for your group then walk to your assigned staging area on Temple Avenue. Check in begins at 8:30am and judging will begin at 10:00am at your assigned staging area. Please have your participants at the staging area by 10:00am if you wished to have your float judged. If you do not wish to have your float judged, your participants should be at the staging area by 10:30am.

It is recommended that units provide wagons pulled by adults for small children who are walking and not riding on the float in the eventuality they have difficulty keeping pace with the parade. In the event that a child tires they can board the wagon and still finish the parade. Please remember that it is an exciting and long day for the little ones and they do tire out. Additionally, it will be several hours from the time you begin staging to the time you reach the end of the parade. We suggest that you bring water for the day and something light to eat before you enter the parade route. Please remind those associated with your entry that the Camarillo Community Center is the parade dispersal area and pick up point for parade participants.

An important reminder to all participants, that for safety reasons the City of Camarillo and the Pleasant Valley Recreation and Park District prohibit the distribution of any items such as candy or promotional information by parade participants during the parade. Entrants are also prohibited from leaving the parade formation in order to collect items along the parade route, with the exception of restroom stops.

Float units will be judged prior to the parade in the staging area at approximately 10:00am. In appreciation of the time and energy that you and your group put into creating a float, the Pleasant Valley Recreation and Park District will place a banner recognizing award recipients in front of each award-winning float as you travel the parade route.

We hope you will attend the Award Presentation at the stage in the Community Center Park and Santa's Village Holiday Carnival immediately following the parade. The award ceremony is scheduled to begin at 2:00pm.

HOW TO GET TO YOUR STAGING AREA.

* Parking will NOT be allowed on Temple Avenue from Las Posas to Amber Drive. Only vehicles that will be in the parade will be allowed on Temple Avenue.

* Use Charter Oak Park as a "meeting area" for your group then walk to your assigned staging area on Temple Avenue.

* Send one representative from your group to the check-in location at the corner of Temple Avenue and Aloha Street.

* Judging begins at approximately 10:00am. If you would like to have your float judged, please have it decorated and all participants at the float by 10:00am.

*If you DO NOT wish to have your float judged, please have all your participants in the staging area and ready to begin the parade by 10:30am.

* Vehicles/motorized floats may not be left unattended. A driver must remain with the vehicle at all times.

*Please share this information with everyone who is involved with your float on the day of the parade.

2009 CAMARILLO CHRISTMAS PARADE GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

All parade participants are asked to comply with the following rules:

1. To avoid gaps in the parade, please do not stop along the parade route. The parade starter will direct you to begin at certain intervals. Please maintain this spacing, and do not close in on preceding units.
2. To insure the safety of spectators, especially children, the distribution or throwing of any items, including candy, by the paraders to the spectators is strictly prohibited.
3. All participants in the parade should be costumed according to the parade theme. All vehicles should be decorated also.
4. There will be only one Santa Claus allowed in the parade and he will ride on the Santa Claus float at the end of the parade.
5. Participants are asked not to race engines, make loud noises, or make quick movements near the equestrian units.
6. No commercial signs with slogans, phone numbers, or addresses may be displayed on any units. You may apply for this signage sponsorship by contacting Parade Headquarters at (805) 482-1996 ext. 18. Signs with logos or identification are allowed.
7. Vehicles should not be left at the parade start or staging area after the last unit has departed unless legally parked.
8. At parade finish (Carmen and Burnley), participants are asked to maintain the same spacing until they reach the Community Center. All units will be dispersed at the Community Center where award ceremonies will be held.
9. Participants are asked to comply with all instructions from parade officials or police officers.
10. No floats or vehicle are to be left unattended.

PARADE ROUTE

The parade begins at 11:00am on the corner of Temple and Las Posas, then proceeds westerly along Las Posas for 1.2 miles (approximately 35 min.) to Carmen Drive where the parade turns left on Carmen and proceeds to Burnley Street. There are many spectators along Carmen Dr., so please remain in formation until you reach Burnley St. Paraders then turn left on Burnley and into the Community Center grounds for dispersal and the awards ceremonies.

AWARDS CEREMONIES

Stage in Community Center Park- all units

Please note: the 2009 Camarillo Christmas Parade Awards Ceremony will be held on the stage located in the Community Center Park. Presentation of awards will begin at the conclusion of the parade beginning at 2:30 p.m. for Auto, Equestrian, Float and Specialty entries will be announced. At 3:00pm awards for Band entries will be announced.

Parade Numbers

All units will be given parade numbers to be worn/displayed during the parade.

In order for the judges and announcers to better differentiate parade unit participants, each parade unit will be given a set of parade line-up numbers. **These are to be placed in a recognizable area. You must check in with your unit director to receive your number.** All units will be given a set of identical numbers, to be displayed on the right and left hand sides of your unit. The following are suggested areas for placement of these numbers.

- If you have a banner, please place this on the right and left hand upper corner of your banner
- **Band** – Display on your school banner on the right and left hand upper corner of your banner, OR on the front row of the of the band. Left shoulder of the far left band member and right shoulder of the far right band member.
- **Auto** – recognizable area on front of car both sides.
- **Specialty** – Either on your banner as mentioned above or on the right upper arm of one of your group and the left upper arm of your group.
- **Float** – On the right and left fronts of whatever vehicle is towing your float.

Remember your numbers need to be seen! Check in with your unit director(s) to receive your assigned parade number. This number will enable the judges and the announcers to get the correct information about your group.

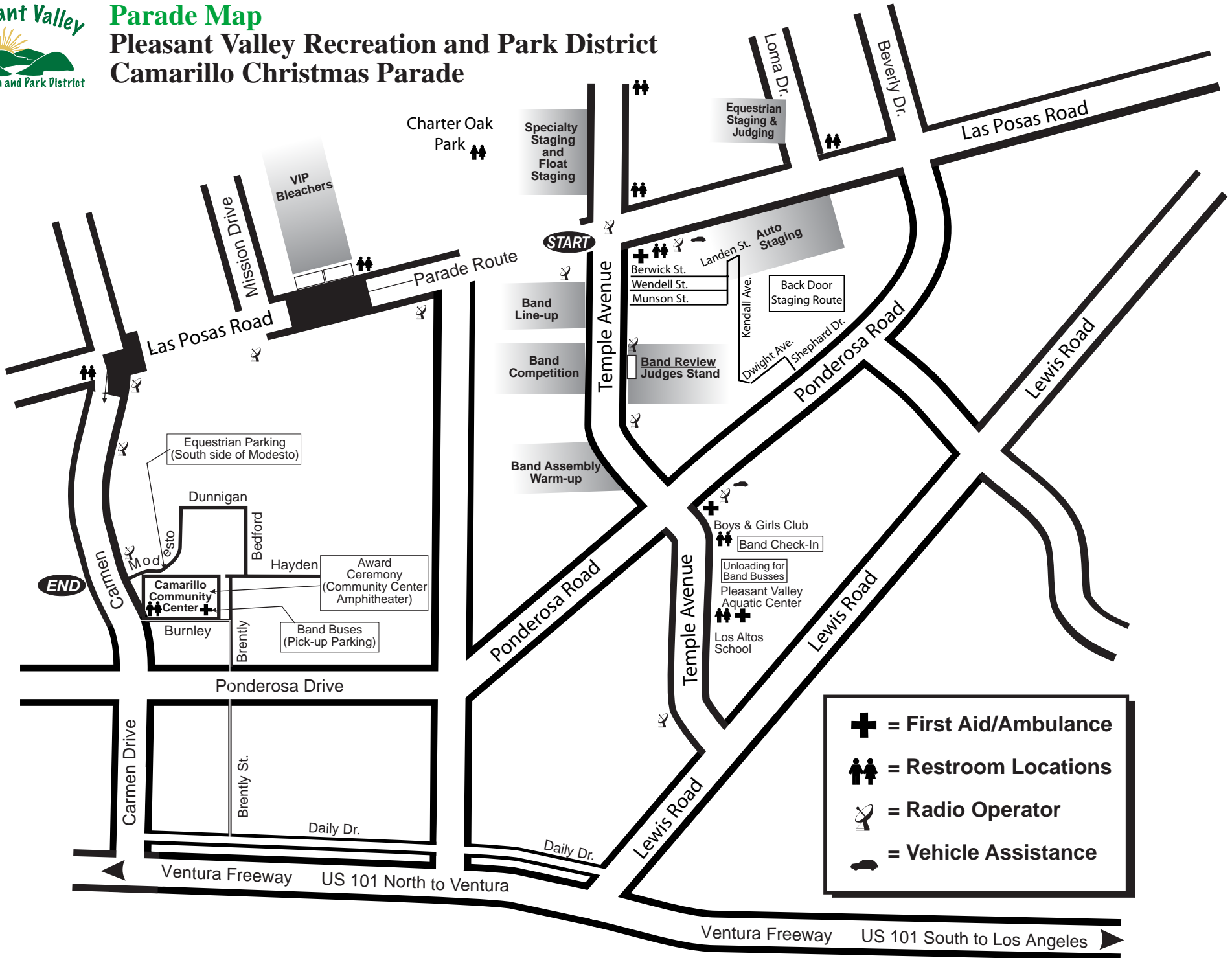


Entry Type	At Staging Area	If on Parade Route
Bands	Buses drop off participants off. Buses will be directed to Community Center after their band has stepped off. If rain begins prior to a bands step off, participants return to bus.	Buses directed to Community Center for pick-up. Participants Continue to Community Center to meet buses.
Autos	Exit staging east on Las Posas to Ponderosa or Lewis Road	Exit at Los Posas to Carmen proceed west
Equestrian	Return to Peace Lutheran Church on Loma for pick-up. Truck and horse trailers notified to return to Peace Lutheran Church on Loma.	Complete route to disembark area with police escort as available.
Floats	Park on Temple in staging area temporarily until notified by parade officials to proceed along parade route to Community Center.	Exit at Carmen and Las Posas or continue to disembarking area.
Specialty	Stay in staging area until picked up by responsible party, then follow procedures outlined for floats above.	Vehicle exit at Los Posas and Carmen and proceed west.
SPECIAL NOTE:	Anyone wishing to deviate from this plan MUST clear his or her alternative plan with a parade Unit Director (i.e. Bands, Floats, Autos, Equestrian and Specialty)

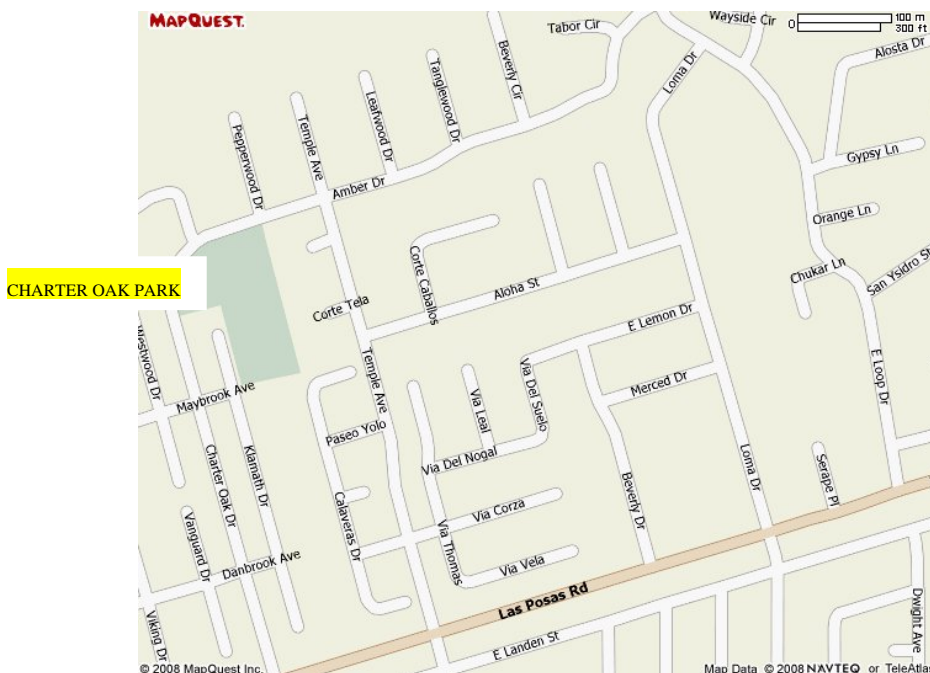
2009 Camarillo Christmas Parade Float/Specialty Driving & Staging Area Directions

On parade day there will be very limited, to no access to traffic on service streets other than Charter Oaks. Access from Temple Ave will not be available as it is the band review area. To ease the flow of traffic in the Float/Specialty staging areas on Temple, east of Las Posas, please adhere to the following directions:

Participants in the Float/Specialty Units should take E. Loop, turn left on Loma Drive and right onto Aloha Drive to check in.. **SEE MAP BELOW.**

Floats and Specialty Units will check-in with parade staff at the intersection of Temple and Aloha. All floats and specialty units will stage on the left side of Temple Avenue. Look for signage denoting your arrival routes the day of the parade. **Check-in will begin at 8:30am.**

NOTE: PARKING ON TEMPLE AVENUE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED. Only Float and Specialty vehicles that will be in the parade will be allowed to drive on Temple Avenue. Parking will be available on Amber and Charter Oak next to the Park.
