PLEASANT VALLEY RECREATION & PARK DISTRICT CLOSURES DUE TO CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

The COVID-19 outbreak continues to be a fluid challenge that Pleasant Valley Recreation & Park District (PVRPD) monitors on an ongoing basis. Over the last several days, significant announcements, guidance, and directives have been issued to help mitigate the spread of the disease. On March 12th, Governor Newsom issued an Executive Order limiting non-essential gathering to no more than 250 people and limiting gatherings of individuals who are at higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19 and to have social distancing of six feet.

Following the orders of the State and Ventura County Public Health officials who recommend the cancellation of public events over 250 people, social distancing at events of less than 250, and cancellation of all non-essential gatherings, PVRPD is taking the following steps as a means of slowing the spread of COVID-19 as of March 14, 2020:

- Indoor facilities closed: Senior Center/Community Center/Freedom/PV East/Dos Caminos
- Cancelling PVRPD classes/activities/sports leagues/preschool
- Cancelling PVRPD special events through the end of April

If you are part of a **Non-PVRPD** organized league or have a private rental, please contact your organization or the PVRPD Administrative Office for more information.

PVRPD parks will remain open during this time for groups under the 250 set guidelines. While enjoying the great outdoors please adhere to the six-foot social distancing guidelines.

The well-being of our community and staff is our highest priority. We apologize for any inconvenience these measures may have caused.
