Class Refunds - If withdrawal/transfer from a program/class is made 5 business days prior to the start of a class there will be a full refund, less a \$10 administrative fee. If withdrawal is made less than 5 business days before the first day of the program, there will be no refund issued. Registrants failing to be present for the program will forfeit all fees paid. No refund will be issued for programs and activities where the registration cost is \$10 or less. Pro-rating is not available for late registration.






