Districting Process

Step	Description			
Two Initial Hearings Sept. 8 and 21	Held prior to release of draft maps. Education and to solicit input on the composition of districts.			
Release draft maps	Maps must be posted at least 7 days prior to 3 rd hearing.			
Two hearings on draft maps Oct. 6 and 28	Two meetings to discuss and revise the draft maps and to discuss the election sequence.			
Map adoption Oct. 28 (Nov. 4 if needed)	Final map must be posted at least 7 days prior to adoption.



- □ Geographic Area, plus
- □ Shared issue or characteristic
 - □ Shared social or economic interest
 - □ Impacted by county policies
- □ Tell us "your community's story"

2nd Question: Would this community benefit from being "included within a single district for purposes of its effective and fair representation"?

• Or would it benefit more from having multiple representatives?

- □ What other notable areas are in the District, and what are their boundaries?
