PLEASANT VALLEY RECREATION & PARK DISTRICT CLOSURES DUE TO CORONAVIRUS ("COVID-19")

The Pleasant Valley Recreation & Park District ("District") prioritizes the health and well-being of residents, guests, and employees. With the continued spread of COVID-19, the District is taking appropriate actions in alignment with Governor Newsom's order, recommendations from the Center for Disease Control and Prevention ("CDC"), and guidance from Ventura County Public Health to limit the spread of COVID-19.

The District is limiting public gatherings, consistent with directives from Governor Newsom and the CDC, effective **March 20, 2020 until further notice**:

- **ALL** District special events, programs and facility rentals (including picnic shelters) are **CANCELLED**.
- **ALL** indoor facilities including the Senior Center, Community Center, Freedom Center, Freedom Gym, and the Pleasant Valley Aquatic Center will remain **CLOSED**.
- Open space, dog parks, and parks are **OPEN**, but playgrounds are **CLOSED**.
- The Pleasant Valley Skatepark is **CLOSED**.
- Tennis/pickleball courts, restrooms, and dog parks are open 7:00am-dusk
