#### IDENTIFICATION

Travel within USA

For travel completed by September 30, 2021, all airlines will ask for identification when you check in. It is recommended that you carry a passport if you have one. A driver's license (with a photo I.D.) is also acceptable for domestic flights.

Effective for travel October 1, 2021 forward, the REAL ID Act standards for identification while travelling will be in effect. This means a standard issued driver's license used as a form of identification will no longer be accepted for domestic air travel within the United States. Instead, a Real ID compliant form of identification must be presented both at the time of booking air travel with Collette and upon checking in at the airport to board any flight. Any fees

Their first completed project in Rockefeller Center was Radio City Music Hall, created to provide top entertainment that was affordable to the public. For 80 years, the theater has hosted the holiday tradition of the Radio City Christmas Spectacular, starring the world-famous Rockettes. Referred to as the best holiday production in America, the Christmas Spectacular draws an audience of one million people every year. This show blends the flawless choreography of the prestigious Rockettes with an abundance of holiday pizzazz. Their precise moves, the upbeat holiday music, and the elaborate costumes and stage décor are simply captivating.
